10. GENERAL BUSINESS

- 10.1 Main oval has been scraped back in order to level it and therefore resolve the run up issue.
- 10.2 D Wescombe spoke to A Galvin about the rangehood in the new kitchen, still no change there. Still trying to source a fan. D Collins to follow up.
- 10.3 C Medlow raised the Team App in order to simplify communications between players, coaches etc. Can notify club members of AGM etc through the app. Free app for all levels of club, would require 1 person to run.
- 10.4 What do we need to do A grade wise, chase a player/player coach require a batsman at least. A few players in the mix to come and play this season one that opened the batting in Adelaide Turf last year. Another player J Bradley was asked to chase as he is playing for Torrens Valley football. Some discussion about not being comfortable to pay a player as this could cause some divide amongst the playing group.
 - 10.4.1 Need more structure to encourage improvement. A lot more players going straight down to town to play. Rather than just showing up to training and having a hit.
 - 10.4.2 G Medlow suggest putting together a sub committee in order to discuss approach and go out and see what players/coach might be looking for in order to come across. Get a player coach, base rate and then performance based. Players would need to buy in to the approach so right coach must be found. Senior A Grade players, President. M Collins have offered to be involved.
 - 10.4.3 Sub Committee D Wescombe, D Collins, M Collins, S Collins, B Collins
 - 10.4.4 Raised if we should put out on social media to see if it can get a conversation started??
 - 10.4.5 Any player/ coach potentials put names forward to sub committee
 - 10.4.6 If we can't find a coach from outside, set up a group of senior players, not necessarily all A Grade, to form a coaching group.
- 10.5 First aid kit should we have an epi pen on site? M Collins moves that the club gets a new full first aid kit Seconded by S Downs
- 10.6 Should be an honor board for bowlers, 5 for in a game nomination for someone to go back and look at list of players that would make to board??
- 10.7 Should we be putting younger to mid age players through coaching courses.

 ACB has grass roots program for free, mostly online and 1 night in town. Could be promoted to the wider club for those who are interested
- 10.8 Long term goal perhaps but could we look into tidying up and sectioning off a part for the girls to change in as we had 3 playing last year and 2 indicated interest in playing again this year. Look at restructuring the space and putting in a door with a lock in order to give them a space that is more private.
- 10.9 Could we look into having a slideshow of sponsors and maybe players once they have paid subs and would like to be.
- 10.10 Matting on the nets has been a success, and we should look at adding to the other nets, the one closest may need to be re-laid or cleaned up. Could look at using existing rollouts to have those glued down. item to be added to agenda for committee to consider
