# 10. Hills Cricket Association

10.1. AGM Report - pretty much all positions are being held by previous holders, only person removed from permits committee B. Oliver, M. Bohmer still umpire co-

- ordinator. All players to wear helmets for batting, will be required to wear with a face guard, Players will be told by the umpires that they must wear a helmet, refusal to do this will result in the game being forfeited. Keepers will be required to wear a helmet when up to the stumps
- 10.2. Mycricket registration to be done as it was last year, juniors mandatory, seniors up to club level to decide.
- 10.3. SACA admin program to be continued this season
- 10.4. Enforcement of Mycricket entry this season by 5pm Monday, penalties will be either financial or loss of points
- 10.5. Team nominations, LC agreed to go up to A2s to make numbers even, Maccy not able to go up to A grade
- 10.6. Umpires to remain the same with the exception of Bruce Phillips, fees will remain the same
