- 16.3. Turf wickets, Nick received a call from SACA on Monday advising that Cricket Australia are looking to give a substantial amount of money to clubs affected by bushfires 2019/20 to put in the turf wicket. There is the potential the Cricket Australia will fund the whole establishment of the pitch. We will need to provide soil testing and provide the feasibility of maintaining a turf wicket. Need to decide if we want to do only the main oval or both the main and back ovals. Potential we will need to provide funds for the machinery which could be substantial. Maintenance of the pitch would also fall to the club, potentially we could find people in the club interested in maintaining this and hopefully enough that we could have a roster of people to do it. Once in a lifetime opportunity to get this funding, this is specifically for a turf wicket, not an option to use elsewhere. Motion to move forward in exploring options for viability, costing and ongoing costs for maintenance and time before making any further decisions Moved by D. Collins seconded P. Reid passed.
