Unfortunately this year already the weather has had an impact on our games causing some to be cancelled but the players are looking forward to better weather for the rest of the season.

This year the under 10 & Have A Go along with their coaches have been lucky enough to have the involvement of some Under 12 & Under 16 players providing tips and helping out where needed. Both the U10 & U12 teams have been involved in the Redbacks LunchBack Program where each team represents the club by playing in a 8-a-side competition during the cricket lunchbreak. The children enjoyed hitting the ball into the crowd and were very involved in the sport for half an hour.

The **Woodside Red U10** team is made up of lots of boys who played together for Onka's under 8 footy team. We have a young team of 7 and 6 year olds with one 5 year old. The highlight so far has been our catching and fielding. Great catches to Zac, Brad, Charlie & Isaac. Liam T has got a run out and Campbell and Liam H are always



backing up in the field. Edward and our dynamic left armers, Charlie & Campbell have been our most consistent bowlers, with very few wides between them. Also our younger bowlers Clem, Teddy and Henry have shown our older team mates how to do it. Almost everyone has taken wicket at this stage of the year. The batting is improving steadily, from our team being out 12 times in our first game, to only 3 times in our

last. Four different batsman have led the scoring in our 4 games, Zac, Henry, Charlie & Isaac, with Harry being close a couple of times.

and the second game was the local Derby Woodside Red Vs Woodside Blue. The fourth match of the season saw Woodside Blue head over to a very cold night at Birdwood. The stalwarts of the team Nick Johns Jnr and Thomas Rooney were best with the bat neither losing their wicket and scoring 10.5 to make a 21 run partnership. Blake Dunow also in his first season and recruited from tennis managed 2/5 off 2 over's with the ball. How quick the Derby came around again with 4 players out Woodside Blue struggled for form, Ryan English stepped up to score 11 runs and Blue managed 2 wickets for their bowling efforts. The warm weather made for a pleasurable trip to Lobethal for our second last game of the year before the break. Declan Hortle and Gracie Floyd paired up in the batting to score a 16 run partnership followed by impressive bowling of 2/5 and 3/6 respectively.

The Under 12s like all the other sides have had a weather interrupted start to the season, and with a change of associations and a twenty20 concept it has made for some interesting stroke play and style of play that has not been conducive to the traditional development of our younger cricketers. All of our players have performed well with both bat and ball and many have hit their first 4s and 6s. The game against Wistow was a highlight our boys ran well between the wickets hit many boundaries and bowled really well. Our most recent game against Hahndorf, was also a great performance - Hahndorf was undefeated up until this game - our boys batted first, made 104 from the twenty overs and restricted Hahndorf to just 64 from their allotted overs. There were many creditable performances Harry Ronan with 18no, Jack Druwitt with 17no, Connor Hortle with 19no and 2for1, John Bliss 8no. Well Done boys keep up the good work. One win and two losses and one bye is a pretty good start to a season for **Under14 Blue**. It's pleasing to see the development of young cricketers, and we



are buoyed by the marked improvement in the lad's skills, their positive attitude, eagerness and desire to get behind each other. The team is well lead by captain Sam Liersch's and deputy Mitchell Reid, who stood in as acting captain in Sam's absence and has lead from the front, with some very nice stoke play and a highlight 30 n.o. Wyatt Green and Ryan Kupke have both reached personal best of 22 n.o and 15 n.o respectively. In fact most of the lads have scored in double figures, and being unfortunate to have to be retired as they were looking to go on. Best of the bowling figures include a 2/6 off 5 overs, 1/6 off 6 overs, 2/8 off 4 overs and a 1/9 off 4, with Mitchell Reid and Jesse Hopgood being the most consistent bowlers. Whilst these figures on their own are impressive it remains an area in greatest need of improvement. All in all there is a great vibe in the team, both with the players and parents who are willing to lend a hand. The boys had an inspiring 57 run win against Paracombe this week—a well deserved win. **GO WOODIES**
