

## WOODSIDE CRICKET CLUB SELECTION GUIDELINES

- All players will be asked to indicate their availability for the next cricket match, by giving their name to the training time keeper.
- It is your responsibility to let your Coach or Captain know if you are not available to play on the weekend.
- On Thursday night's prior to each match the teams will be selected. Players will be advised of team selections when all sides have been completed. These teams will be posted on the internet the following day.
- Players who are not able to train must contact either the Coach or Captain for explanation.
- If for some unknown reason you are not able to play you must notify your Captain immediately. Failure to do this will let your team mates down and adversely affect your chances for selection in subsequent matches.
- Any players with an issue related to their selection or non selection should talk to a member of the selection committee.
- Selection criteria includes, but is not limited to, match performance, training attendance, and payment of club membership or part there of.
- With exception of the above point, match performance is the number one criterion evaluated in selection.
- Every player must have a role to play within the team every match. These roles can and will change from match to match.
- Senior players will have preference before junior players in the B grade teams. A core player list must be named at the start of each season consisting of 8 players.
- The B grade or development team will be exempt from the above point. A core list of players will still need to be named.
- Selected junior players will be named by the Coach and A Grade Captain to develop throughout the season in higher grades A or A2 and will be exempt from the above points. These will be named at the start of the season.
